

CA-D200, Sigma Mono, Sigma AMP2 and Sigma AMP5 firmware update procedure

1. Visit www.classeaudio.com. Operating software can be found under **SERVICE & SUPPORT → SOFTWARE & CODES → Operating software** and choose the amplifier model.
2. Download the latest released software (.zip file) and extract/unzip the archive onto your local computer. Note that while the folder name is CAD-200, this folder is used also for the Sigma Mono, Sigma AMP2 and Sigma AMP5.
3. Copy the CAD-200 folder onto a clean, empty USB stick. The USB stick will then have a folder named CAD-200 at the root level *(if the folder is located within another folder or if the folder's name is different in any way, the update will not proceed)*.
4. Confirm that you have a folder named CAD-200 on the USB stick then eject the USB stick from your computer. Make sure the AC plug is not plugged to unit before plugging the USB stick into the backside USB port of the CA-D200, Sigma Mono, Sigma AMP2 and Sigma AMP5.
5. Plug AC cord into the amplifier. Transfer will begin and should not take longer than a few seconds. You will notice the front LED providing status of the firmware transfer. This will be demonstrated by a different color of LED on the front of the amplifier followed by a red LED indicating that the amplifier is now in standby mode. At that stage, the new firmware has successfully been updated. Simply remove the key and the amplifier is ready for use.
